Others:

Each competition (sprint, slalom) gets points according to the IRF race rules.

Sprint – winner gets 200 points

Slalom – winner gets 300 points

Organizer reserves the right to change the organization of the race.

Every competitor starts at own risk.

Life jacket with a minimum flotation of 7 kg and safety wild water helmet are mandatory!

The organizing committee will have the seat at main stand. Informations for competitors will be on the blue notice-boards in front of main stand.
